Vladimir Grigorian is a virtuoso kamancha player and artistic director-conductor of popular traditional instrumental ensembles in Armenia and abroad. He is a world-renowned concert soloist and has played for large audiences in The Kennedy Center, Carnegie Hall, Alex, Kodak and Ford Theaters, and more.

Besides being qualified as an orchestra conductor, lecturer, and being a strong advocate to promote Armenian folk instrumental music, Mr Grigorian is also a member of the Armenian Composers and Theater Arts Union, and a committee for State Radio and Television. He has also collaborated with renowned dance-master Vanoush Khnamirian as the artistic-director for his instrumental ensemble.
